2. The Council on Trade & Industry will be a forum for policy dialogue on important economic and other issues relevant to trade and industry between Government and Trade and Industry.

3. Finance Minister, Minister of Commerce & Industry, Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission and Chairman, EAC will be permanent special invitees to the Council. The Council, with the permission of the Chairman, may coopt or invite any other such person(s) as it deems appropriate, to participate in any of its sessions as special invitee(s).

4. The Council shall meet as and when it is considered necessary, at a venue and date as may be decided by the Chairman.

5. The Council will be covered within the definition/explanation of High Level Commissions/ Committees as given in Cabinet Secretariat OM NO.1 05/1/1/75-CF, dated 20.11.1975.

6. The TA/DA of the non-official members of the Council (as admissible to Grade-I officers of the highest category in Government of India) shall be paid by the PMO.

7. The Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion will assist the Prime Minister's Office in servicing the Council.
